

spring 2019 city manager's message



Spring brings back activity to our lives, and there is definitely a lot of activity to look forward to in the coming months in the City.

This spring kicks off the first of many exciting events for the year with the City's Easter Egg Hunt, Pancake Breakfast & Resource Fair on April 20, 2019. Next, we will be partnering with the Stanton Community Foundation to host the 18th Annual Spring Car Show and Kids Fair on May 11, 2019. Please join us as we celebrate spring with activities and events for you and your family to enjoy!

In addition to the community events and activities, we will continue to see new business activity and development in the City. Development is well underway on a number of large projects in the City, with the largest being the Village @Beach and Lantana @Beach, the development at the south end of the City at the intersection of Beach Blvd. and Garden Grove Blvd. This project is inclusive of 10 acres of commercial development and 12 acres of residential development. The tenants currently signed on to the commercial project include Chase Bank, Planet Fitness, Raising Cane's and In-n-Out Burger, with many more to come. This project is anticipated to open to the public in Summer/Fall of 2019.

The Stanton Plaza development at the corner of Beach Blvd. and Orangewood Ave. is also near completion, with Wendy's Restaurant operating, and Hiccups and Churroholic nearing operation.

The site will be completed with a new service station, convenience store and car wash, and is anticipated to be operational in Spring 2019.

There are also opportunities for residents to participate in the development activity by utilizing the Residential Rehabilitation Improvement Program. This program provides financial assistance up to \$5,000 to qualified residents conducting exterior improvements to their home, and is a great opportunity to continue beautifying the City.

One final bit of activity, the City is currently in the process of accepting and reviewing applications for the permanent City Manager position. The City has received a lot of interest and is excited for the quality of candidates. The goal would be to have the new permanent City Manager on board sometime this Spring.

I will continue to keep you updated on the many different activities in our City. You can also stay current on City happenings, projects and events by subscribing to my monthly newsletter and by following the City of Stanton on social media.






