fall 2019 city manager's message



Thank you Stanton community for another fantastic summer! We hope you and your families had the opportunity to spend some quality time together enjoying the summer sun! As summer turns to fall, be sure to browse the classes portion of this brochure for an array of enriching

afterschool programs and classes to keep the fun going all year long.

In February, the Stanton City Council adopted a revised Permit Parking ordinance and revised Residential Permit Parking Guidelines. In accordance with the California Attorney General recommendations, multi-family properties can now be included in the permit parking program. Each residential unit, such as a home or an apartment, can be issued up to three permits, valid for a two-year period from January 1, 2020 until December 31, 2021. Applications for new parking permit zones are available now. All existing permits, including visitor hangtags, will expire as of December 31, 2019. New permits will begin to be issued to all available residents on October 1, 2019. For additional information, please visit the City website.

This fall welcomes the continued redevelopment of our Beach Boulevard corridor. Development is well underway on a number of large projects in the City with the largest being the Beach & 22 and Lantana @ Beach mixed-use development at the intersection of Beach Blvd. and Garden Grove Blvd. This project is inclusive of 10 acres of commercial development and 208 condominium units. The tenants currently signed on to the commercial project include Chase Bank, Planet Fitness, Raising Cane's and In-n-Out Burger, and a new Market Hall, Rodeo 39, which will include over a dozen restaurant opportunities, retail shops, a bar, a brewery and plenty of outdoor patio space to enjoy the southern California sunshine. This project is anticipated to open to the public this winter. Other projects underway include an assisted living facility, a new mixed-use project and new commercial activities, all along Beach Blvd. As we welcome these development activities, we also want to show our support of our existing businesses by conducting monthly business visits. If you know a business that would like to participate in these visits, to speak with

key members of the City staff and City Council, and provide us with input on how business is going and whether there is anything the City can do to help, please have them reach out to us to schedule a visit.

The City of Stanton is a proud partner of the Renew Beach Boulevard Coalition whose goal it is to improve the appearance, ambience and accessibility of Beach Boulevard. The Coalition is excited to announce "Meet on Beach," coming up on November 17. This all-day event will connect seven Orange County cities for the first time to bring awareness to pedestrian safety and encourage alternative modes of transportation. Stanton's portion of "Meet on Beach" will include hands-on workshops at Stanton Park, drawing attention to the pedestrian experience and first-mile/last-mile connections in our City.

In addition to "Meet on Beach," don't forget to mark your calendars for all of the exciting Community Services events coming up this fall and winter including Halloween Fest, our Veterans Day Celebration and the annual Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony. Details and additional events can be found on the back cover. We can't wait to see you there!




