7A. **NAME SELECTION FOR COMMUNITY NEWS AND ACTIVITIES GUIDE**

REPORT IN BRIEF:

In May 2018 Community Services Manager Erin Burke directed staff to submit suggestions for a new name for the Community News and Activities Guide. After gathering suggestions, staff narrowed the options to the top two: Stanton Express and Stanton Key. A poll was conducted through Facebook and Twitter with the top two names, and Stanton Express received the majority of the community's vote.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. Parks, Recreation & Community Services Commission declare that the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") under Section 15061(b)(3) as the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in

question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA; and


2. Select a new name for the Community News and Activities Guide from the top two options recommended by voting of City staff and the community.
