7A. SELECTION OF NEW NAME FOR THE COMMUNITY NEWS AND ACTIVITIES GUIDE

REPORT IN BRIEF:

In June 2018 Community Services Manager Erin Burke presented alternative titles for the Community News and Activities Guide to the Commission. The Commission asked that the item be brought back with additional information, at a future meeting when more Commissioners are present.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. Parks, Recreation & Community Services Commission declare that the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") under Section 15061(b)(3) as the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA; and

2. Approve the Stanton Express as the new title for the Community News and Activities Guide.
