CAL VIP GRANT

On December 31st 2017 the GRIP Grant 2 year funding ended from the State of California. The Community Services Department along with the Orange County

Sheriff's Department worked extremely hard to help make a difference with the children in the community on truancy reduction. Senator Josh Newman has provided funding to the City along with 10 other cities in his district. This grant is called the North Orange County Community Task Force also known NOC Grant. The NOC Grant allows us to continue to do what we were doing before with the GRIP Grant but on a smaller scale. The State of California has a RFP out for a new grant called Cal VIP Grant (Violence Intervention and Prevention). The City is currently working on completing and applying for this grant by the deadline. It's not a large funded grant but with both NOC and Cal VIP it will help to make more of an impact in the City. Staff will keep the Commission updated on status of the Cal VIP grant once the City hears from the State.
