SAFETY ALERT – NOTICE REGARDING COVID-19

The President, Governor, and the City of Stanton have declared a State of Emergency as a result of the threat of COVID-19 (aka the "Coronavirus"). REPORT IN BRIEF:

In 2018 voters passed Proposition 68, the \$4 billion "Parks, Environment, and Water Bond Act of 2018". The fourth and final round for this project has \$395.3 million in competitive funding available. Staff is proposing the Norm Ross Sports Complex Renovation Project for this program.
